The Summit Country Day Covid-19 and Illness Protocol

What to do if your child is ill:

- Keep students at home if they are feeling sick.
- Students with a temperature of 100F may not attend school. Student must be fever free for 24 hours without the use of fever reducing medicine before they may return to school.
- Students with gastrointestinal illness (vomiting and diarrhea) may not return to school until they have gone 24 hours without an episode of either symptom.
- For any symptom (headache, fever, fatigue, gastrointestinal, cold symptoms, and/or sore throat) development after a known Covid-19 exposure, student must remain at home and may return to school with a negative test conducted after 48 hours of symptom onset and with adherence to the Mask to Stay policy stated below.

*The school nurse, on a case-by-case basis, will determine when each student may safely return to in person learning.

Testing:

- Please notify school nurse if your student tests positive for Covid-19, Flu, Strep or other communicable illnesses to help assist in monitoring for disease spread.

- For Covid-19 testing, the school is able to administer the test on site, please reach out to the school nurse. All other testing needs to be conducted through your health care provider.

Exposure to Covid-19-All students regardless of vaccination status **Mask to stay**

- Wear a mask for 10 days from date of exposure.
- Masking can discontinue after day 5 with a negative test.
- Asymptomatic students may continue to attend practices and games.
- If symptoms develop, begin isolation, and get tested 48 hours after symptom onset.
- Students who have had a positive Covid-19 test within 90 days of exposure are not required to mask or test unless symptoms develop.
- Montessori and Toddler:
 - Please contact the school nurse. Safe return to school will be determined on a case by case basis.
