Responsibilities:

- Teach 3 sections of College Prep (CP) Trigonometry and Pre-Calculus.
- Use a multitude of instructional strategies and activities that are academically rigorous and highly engaging.
- Be present and available for service to the school from 7:30 AM until noon on most days.
- Provide classroom management to create a culture of academic achievement.
- Monitor student progress and assist students in accomplishing established learning objectives.
