

## ADDITIONAL INFORMATION FOR NEW STUDENTS STATE LAW AND SCHOOL REQUIREMENTS

In order to comply with State Law and school requirements, the following must be on file in our Admission Office **before your child can be admitted to class on the first day of school.** Please forward this material as soon as possible.

**IMMUNIZATIONS** - The Summit adheres to the Ohio Department of Health (ODH) guidelines for immunizations for school attendance. The Summit reports to the state annually that it possesses a complete vaccination record on file for each enrolled student from birth to date. A student shall not be permitted to stay in school for more than **14 calendar days**, from the first day of school for their division, unless the parent presents written or electronic documentation regarding the student's immunization status and compliance. Student athletes in grades 7-12 will not be eligible to practice or compete without a complete vaccination record on file. If a child is unable to receive a vaccine due to a medical condition, a note from a physician must be submitted for review by the school's infectious disease advisors. We do not accept exemptions for religious or good cause reasons. Once your child is enrolled, you will receive access to our online health management tool- Magnus Health. It will provide you with all health and immunization requirements and the forms needed to submit to the school. **COVID VACCINATIONS** - We strongly encourage eligible students to receive their Covid vaccination and approved boosters prior to starting school.
